

How to Download eBooks or Audiobooks to your Mobile Device

If you are comfortable installing apps to your mobile device, visit your mobile device's "Market" or "App Store" to search for, download and install "OverDrive Media Console", then proceed directly to step 5 of this document.

If you need assistance installing OverDrive Media Console, proceed to step 1 below.

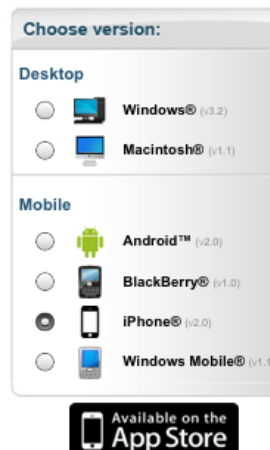
1. Go to the MYlibrary2Go web page (<http://midyork.lib.overdrive.com>) using your device's web browser.
2. At the bottom of the screen, click on "OverDrive Media Console" (iPad/iPhone version shown below, but your particular mobile device version will appear when you connect to the site):



If you do not see the blue OverDrive button, go to the following web site address:

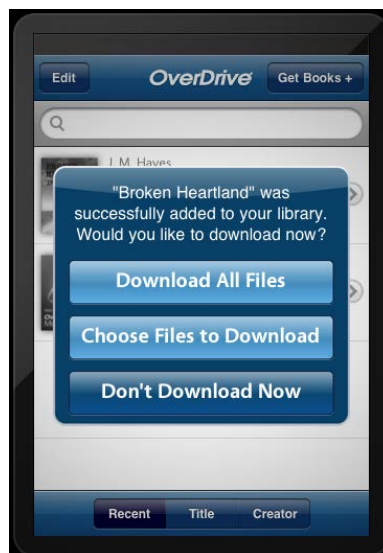
3. If your device's Market/App Store has a version of OverDrive for your device, you will automatically be prompted to install the free program. If you must go to the OverDrive web page to download the app, on the OverDrive web page, under "Choose version", click on the radio button next to your mobile device name (the iPhone version is the same as that used for the iPad), then click on the button labeled "Available on the App Store"



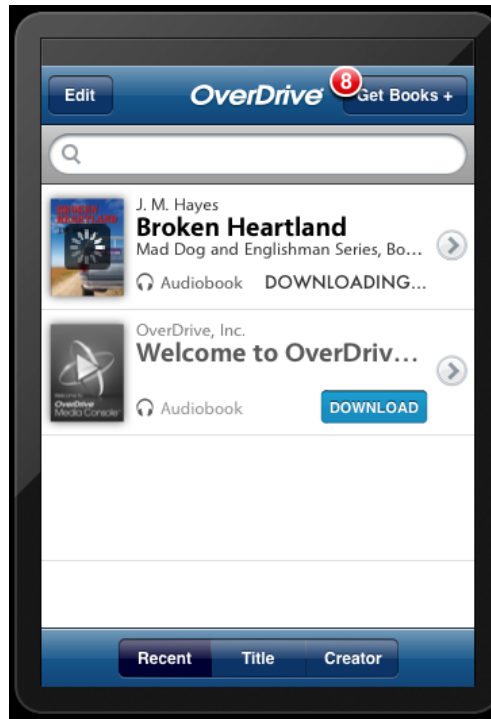
- Once on the "OverDrive Media Console" page, click on the "FREE" icon below the OverDrive icon, then click again after it turns into "INSTALL APP" (the pictures below show how this step appears on an Apple device. Your mobile device may display this part slightly different).



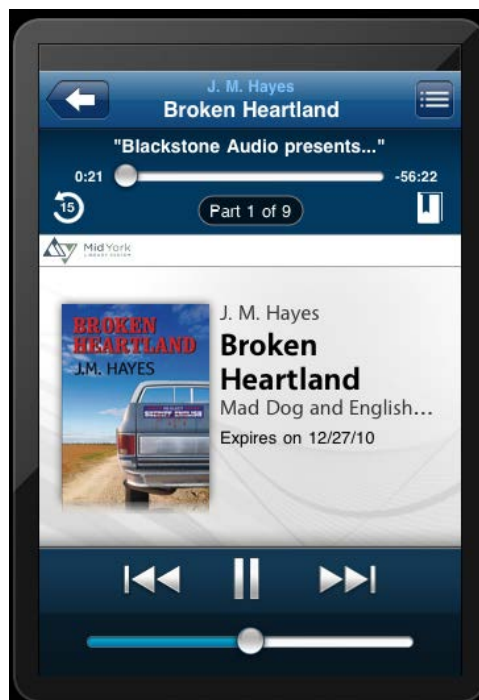
- If you have an Apple device, you may be prompted to enter a password or the OverDrive download and install may automatically start if your device has remembered this information from a previous event. Some Apple messages may ask if you want to "Buy" the OverDrive program. This is a fault with Apple's process, since the OverDrive program is free. Simply agree to "buy" the program. You will not be prompted to enter credit card information and there will be no charge for the app.
- After "OverDrive" has been successfully installed open the library web page again, find the eBook or Audiobook you want to download, and click on "Add to cart". If this is your only selection, click on "Proceed to Checkout".
- When prompted, login to your MYLibrary2Go account using your Library card number and PIN. Click on the **Confirm check out** button, then the **Download** button.
- If this is your first time using the OverDrive app on your device, and you are downloading an Adobe ePub eBook, you will be prompted to enter your Adobe ID (if you do not yet have an Adobe ID, please refer to the document "How to Create an Adobe ID". After your Adobe ID is created, follow the instruction on your device to enter the ID.
- You will be prompted to download some or all of the individual chapters in your eBook/Audiobook:



10. Your download may take some time. You can view the download progress in the OverDrive window (notice the red circle with number at the top of the screen... the number indicates how many chapters of this eBook/Audiobook are left to download):



11. After your eBook/Audiobook has been downloaded, simply touch the book you just checked out and it will open in the OverDrive window (the screen shot below shows an Audiobook):
